Thank you for choosing Centerpoint Church's Awana Club program for your children! We at Centerpoint are firm supporters of Awana Club, sharing the common goal to raise kids with a strong faith in Jesus Christ.

Awana Club started almost seventy-five years ago and is now available in over 75,000 churches all around the world. It's carefully tailored curriculum, ranging from verse memorization, games, and Bible teaching, aims to teach children how the Bible applies to everyday life. Attached to this letter you will find a registration form, the Awana policies, a calendar for the 2024-2025 Awana Club, and a payment form, all of which will need to be filled out and turned in before your children can begin Awana. If you wish to save time on the first night of club, you are encouraged to bring your completed packet to church by Sunday September 8th. If you prefer to wait, packets will be accepted on the first night of Awana, which will be Tuesday, September 10th.

Again, thank you for choosing Awana Club at Centerpoint Church for your children. We as a staff are excited to get to know your children this year and see how the Lord works in their lives.

Awana Policies and Procedures

<u>Time</u> - Awana is held every Tuesday evening consistent with the MISD calendar, with a few exceptions (please see the attached 2024-2025 Awana calendar). Awana begins at 6:00pm and ends promptly at 7:40pm. Check-in will begin at 5:50. Children will not be allowed into the church before 5:50pm, unless they belong to an Awana leader.

<u>Ages</u> - Awana is open to all children ages 3-12, or pre-k through 6th grade. All Cubbies (kids ages 3-4) must be potty trained.

Payment - The average cost for one child to attend Awana for a full year is \$80. Centerpoint Church pays for over half the cost, meaning parents are asked to pay just \$35 per child. This includes uniforms, handbooks, awards, theme night and craft supplies, and snacks. A \$10 price break is given to third and fourth children. This money may be paid in full up front, or half at the beginning of each semester (Please fill out attached payment form). If you are unable to pay the full amount, scholarships are available. Please see Andy Howard. We don't want any children left out of Awana because of money! Payment can be made by check or online at www.centerpointmesquite.org/awana No cash payments will be accepted this year.

<u>Drop-off/Check-in</u> - Your child will be required to check in upon arrival at Awana each week and must be accompanied by an adult. The adult will need to sign their children in, leave an emergency phone number, and communicate who will be picking their children up that night. Children will not be allowed to participate in Awana until a parent/adult has checked them in.

<u>Pick-up</u> - Your children will need to be picked up from their individual classrooms, not from the main room. *Please limit visiting with other parents until you have gathered all your children and have exited the building*. Adult supervision is minimal after 7:40 as leaders leave, so please do not be late picking your children up.

<u>Attire</u> - In addition to sending your kids in their Awana uniforms each week, please also send them in clothing appropriate for running, jumping, bending over, sitting on the floor, etc. (i.e. no short skirts, low waist-lines, dangly jewelry, etc.). Athletic shoes are recommended and **your child/ren will not be permitted to play games without shoes.**

<u>Bags</u> - Children are encouraged to bring their personal belongings in a bag or backpack each week to help ensure that they leave with everything they came with. Please label everything you send with your children - Bibles, uniforms, handbooks, jackets, etc. Centerpoint Church is not responsible for lost items.

<u>Verse Memorization</u> - Parents are strongly encouraged to work with their children on Bible verses outside of Awana. Each club is given a 20-minute time slot during Awana to study and recite verses but children are encouraged to come prepared to recite, especially the younger ones who cannot read and study on their own. Club directors may limit the number of sections a child may recite in order ensure that each child is given fair opportunity to recite verses. *(turn page over)*

<u>Friends/Visitors</u> - Kids are encouraged to bring their friends to Awana! Friends are welcome at any time and are not required to fill out a registration packet unless their attendance becomes regular (2-3 consecutive Awanas, or verbal communication with Awana leadership that the parents of the child wish to send their child on a regular basis). At that time, a registration packet will be sent home to the parents and will be required in order for the child to continue in Awana. For the one-time visitors, the parent of the child bringing the visitor will be the emergency contact for the visitor.

<u>Snacks</u> - Children will be fed a small snack during Awana on theme nights only (a cookie, a cup of popcorn, fruit-snacks, etc.). PLEASE INDICATE ANY FOOD ALLERGIES ON YOUR REGISTRATION FORM!

<u>Communication</u> - Email updates will be sent out as needed and will be the primary means of communication from the Awana staff to you. If you do not have an email account and wish to receive phone calls instead, please tell Andy Howard.

<u>Cancellation of Awana</u> - In the case of severe weather, sickness, or other unforeseen circumstances, Awana will be cancelled at the commander's discretion. In that case, we will email the parents by 2:00pm on the day of Awana.

<u>Sickness</u> - PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILDREN TO AWANA IF THEY ARE SICK! Sick children at Awana affect more than those particular children, but all those around them, including leaders, other children, and all of their families. Please keep your children at home if they have any of the following:

- 1. Runny nose with any colored discharge
- 2. Fever or diarrhea within the past 24 hours
- 3. Sore throat or cough
- 4. Any skin infection or unexplained rash
- 5. Pinkeye or other eye infection
- 6. If the child or anyone in their household has vomited within the past 24 hours.

<u>Discipline</u> - Awana will operate consistently with the Centerpoint Church Children's Ministries' discipline policy. We do not administer corporal punishment, even if the parents have given permission for it. A child having difficulty cooperating in class will be:1) instructed on good behavior, and if instruction isn't sufficient,

- 2) given time to consider good behavior in the hall with an adult, and if time in the hall isn't sufficient.
- 3) sent home early with his/her parent with the opportunity to return on another day.

<u>Child Protection</u> - Centerpoint Church seeks to provide a safe and secure environment for children who participate in Awana and all other programs and ministries. Our workers are selected carefully and trained according to Centerpoint's Child Protection Policy.
